### ***Chevron pays \$2.2 million in e-mail Sexual Harassment case***

Chevron certainly wishes it had known. Last year the oil company paid \$2.2 million to settle a sexual harassment lawsuit over its e-mail content. The suit was brought by a group of women employees that alleged a Chevron subsidiary allowed its internal email system to be used to transmit sexually offensive messages
